- The Charleston Place – Iconic historic hotel in downtown Charleston
- Hotel Bennett – Historic property on King Street featuring a rooftop bar and full-service spa
- The Dewberry – Modern luxury hotel near Marion Square with striking mid-century architecture
- The Ryder Hotel – Boutique historic hotel located on Meeting Street
- The Spectator Hotel – 1920s-inspired boutique hotel with a speakeasy-style bar
- Zero George – Charming historic house-turned-hotel just off East Bay Street

THINGS TO DO

- Arthur Ravenel Jr. Bridge – Stroll or bike along this iconic bridge connecting Charleston to Mount Pleasant, with sweeping views of the Cooper River and the city skyline
- Beaches – Relax at Sullivan’s Island, Isle of Palms, or Folly Beach
- Carriage and Walking Tours – Explore Charleston’s historic streets and learn fascinating stories about the city
- Charleston Gaillard Center – The Danish Radio Big Band will perform on Saturday evening at this iconic venue, a must-visit for music lovers
- Charleston Museum – America’s first museum, founded in 1773, showcasing local history and culture
- Fort Sumter National Monument – Visit the site where the first shots of the Civil War were fired
- Ghost Tours – Discover Charleston’s haunted history on an evening walking tour
- Gibbes Museum of Art – Regional and American art in a beautifully restored historic building
- Nearby Towns – Visit nearby Georgetown, South Carolina and Beautiful, South Carolina for the day
- Rainbow Row – Stroll past the city’s iconic row of colorful historic homes
- Shem Creek – Located in Mount Pleasant; enjoy a boat ride or take in the stunning sunsets
- Shopping – Browse boutiques along King Street or explore local crafts at Charleston City Market
- The Battery – Scenic waterfront promenade lined with historic mansions
- Waterfront Park – Snap a photo at the famous Pineapple Fountain and enjoy views of the Cooper Riv
